(Campus MONOD) is an Établissement Public d'Enseignement et de Formation Professionnelle Agricole near Rennes. Our structure is built around 4 constituent centers: high school for general and technological education, which has the particularity of hosting sections of the French national education, a farm focused on dairy, pork, sheep and market garden production (all organic); and two training centers for adults and apprentices.

Missions

- Raising our students' awareness of international solidarity and cultural diversity.
- Participation in and organization of festivals
- Promote our young people's openness to the international community.
- The volunteer will contribute to the preparation and organization of International Solidarity Week.
- Raising students' awareness of European mobility and supporting young people in their mobility projects

Accommodations and Trainings

The volunteer will have a room in a furnished apartment at the Lycée, and will share living quarters with language assistants also assigned to the school for the year (kitchen, dining room, bathroom and toilets) He or she will be able to use the Lycée's catering service from Monday morning to Friday lunchtime (breakfast, lunch and dinner. The travel expenses will be reimbursed on the basis defined by the European Commission. Pocket money will be provided, plus money for covering the food and local transport expenses.

The volunteer will take part in an on : - Arrival seminar and mid-term evaluation, organised by the French National Agency - Internal training in the Lycée Theodore Monod - Languages courses and regular mentoring

Profil

The volunteer must be dynamic, open to others, to languages and to the cultural diversity of Europe. He/she must be willing to exchange ideas and benefit from the richness of the proposed environment. Motivation to work with others will be a determining factor. Volunteers must have a minimum of autonomy to make the most of the various opportunities. He/she will need to adapt to an audience of high school and university students. An interest in intercultural issues, international solidarity and the environment is expected. An interest in sports and art would be a plus.
